For most UK-issued cards (e.g. Visa, Mastercard), the Security Code can be found on the back of the card, at the top right of the signature strip. In this case, the number required is the last 3 digits.

On other cards (e.g. American Express) a 4 digit Security Code can be found above the full long number on the front of the card.

Notes

1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying Women's Aid.
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that Women's Aid reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration.
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment tax return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask Women's Aid or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 *Gift Aid*.
